application identification

If you are a victim of domestic violence Surrey Women's Centre can help you apply for income assistance.

REQUIRED

1. Social Insurance Number

SIN Card or Federal government issued document (e.g. Notice of Assessment)

2. One (1) piece primary (photo) identification

PRIMARY ID

BC Identification (BCID) Card

Canadian Driver's License

Passport

Original citizenship papers or immigration documents – these include:

Record of Landing (IMM1000)

Sponsorship Undertaking: Confirmation of Permanent Residence (IMM5292)

Permanent Resident Card

Refugee Protection Claim

Temporary Resident Permit (IMM1442)

Correctional Service of Canada Offender Identification Card

3. One (1) piece secondary identification

SECONDARY ID

Birth Certificate

Citizenship papers or immigration documents (without photos)

Credit Card

Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Native Status Card

Other documents that would be considered acceptable identification for cheque cashing purposes

4. One (1) piece of secondary identification for each dependent child
